The foundation's slogan is "We are for those who possess indomitable wisdom," and it was established in 2018 by Misbah Ahmed Chowdhury, with Rajib Kumar Roy as the Chief Executive. Many people from various classes and occupations contribute directly or indirectly to the foundation, with all the work being carried out physically by the voluntary organization "Boosters."

Boosters, formed by positive-thinking individuals in society, has already made an impact with their work. They have helped facilitate students and their guardians from all over the country who came to take the admission exam-2018 of Shahjalal University of Science and Technology, providing 250 motorbikes to transport them to the exam hall during heavy rainfall. They have also worked for helpless people and fallen students, including ensuring medical treatment for the poor, planting trees, identifying blood groups for free, and conducting the tasks of the M.A. Samad Chowdhury Foundation.

The foundation's principles of "quality education, ethics, tolerance, and progressive thinking" guide their work, which includes providing scholarships and mid-day meals for students, providing materials to schools, helping the "Usha School" for tea state's children in Lakkatura, Sylhet, with educational materials, conducting blood group identification campaigns, and assisting flood-affected people. Their work has been praised by people across the world, and the magazine "Adamyia" is published to showcase their good deeds.

The author expresses gratitude for all those who helped publish the magazine, and apologizes for any unintentional mistakes. The MA Samad Chowdhury Foundation will continue its good work in the future, bringing smiles to the faces of helpless people and giving hope to endangered populations. The Samad Chowdhury Foundation is making great strides in helping the poor. Their initiatives will continue to make a difference in the future. 

Rehena Begum was born blind. Two daughters and one son are born blind. Husband Omar Ali is also unable to do such work. They live in Noorani Bankalapara, Subidbazar, Sylhet. Including her, 4 of the 5 members of the family are born blind. That is why it is impossible for them to earn and run the family. It is not possible for them to beg for social self-respect. MA Samad Chowdhury Foundation found the family living inhuman life with some government allowances and people's help. Later, the organization took some responsibility for the helpless family.



A veteran woman Anjali Barman. She sat on the pavement in Madina Market area of Sylhet with some inexpensive vegetables. But, the vegetable sellers and hawkers nearby do not allow her to sit there. Even they drive the old woman away for their own benefit. Anjali has no courage to protest.

Such cruelty forced her to leave the sidewalk and take a place inside the alley. From morning to night, hot sun or stormy rain, she waits for the buyer in the hope of a small sale. This is how Anjali Barman's family survives with what she earns throughout the day. Although, she had a village house in the remote area of Tahirpur in Sunamganj. She was unable to do anything there resulting moved to Sylhet city. At present, she lives in a slum in Natunbazar area of the city.

The elderly husband Suvash Barman is also not able to do work. She has four children and each are girl. So the matter of survive, the only earning person in the family is the old woman Anjali Barman. In such a situation, when many people of her age survive by begging for a living, the struggling Anjali Barman is fighting to survive in the struggle of life with her best.

Misbah Ahmed Chowdhury, the founder of M.A Samad Chowdhury Foundation came to know about Anjali Barman's condition. As always, Samad Chowdhury Foundation, standing by the helpless deprived people, supports Anjali Barman with new shop and capital. As a result of their humanitarian initiative, struggler Anjali Barman saw a new dream. Another backward family found a better life through Samad Chowdhury Foundation.

There are 162 tea gardens in Bangladesh. 138 of them are in Sylhet. Nearly seven lakh working populations are dependent on tea industry. They are the lowest paid worker in Bangladesh. Most of the students of this school are not economically solvent as they come from rural areas. Under this circumstances, running campaigns like identification of blood group and providing study materials was impossible. In 2022, MA Samad Chowdhury Foundation came with the help we need. We received study materials for 130 students from them. Their efforts are appreciated all over the locality.
